Sie	you singular /plural, formal

„We use the informal second person pronouns du (singular) and ihr (plural) when addressing children, good friends, family members or relations. Colleagues at work also often use the du/ihr form if they get on well together. The formal address pronoun Sie (both singular and plural) is used between strangers and adults who don't know each other well. It is also quite common for colleagues at work to use the Sie form even though they have known each other for years.

The formal und polite forms Sie/Ihnen remain the same in both the singular and plural. They are always written with a capital letter“.^{1*}
